

Mill Lane, from its junction with Marmion Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Bolebridge Street/Ankerdrive.

Spinning School Lane, from its junction with Marmion Street in a westerly direction to its junction with Lower Gungate.

Lower Gungate, from its junction with Spinning School Lane in a northerly direction to its junction with Albert Road/Upper Gungate/Aldergate and Hospital Street.

Lower Gungate (Pedestrianised Zone), from its junction with Spinning School Lane in a southerly direction to its junction with Church Street/Colehill.

Victoria Road, from its junction with Colehill and Bolebridge Street in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Mill Lane.

Bolebridge Street, from its junction with Mill Lane/Ankerdrive in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Colehill /Victoria Road.

The Taunton Deane Borough (A38 Wellington New Road and Stonegallows, Taunton, 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that on 18th May 1994 the Taunton Deane Borough Council made an Order under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the following section of road:

A38 (Principal Road): Wellington New Road and Stonegallows, Taunton, from the termination of the existing 40 m.p.h. speed limit west of the Silk Mills Road Roundabout south-westwards for a distance of approximately 1,130 metres.

The Order came into operation on 1st July 1994.

A copy of the Order and maps showing the location of the roads concerned may be inspected at The Deane House, Belvedere Road, Taunton, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds that they were not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 8th July 1984, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
