The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

- 1. An Order under sections 10, 41 and 106 of the Highways Act 1980 which will:
  - (a) provide that 3 slip roads which he proposes to construct along outes to connect the A428 Trunk Road (at its junction with Norse Road) with the new trunk road to be constructed by him as a southern bypass of Bedford shall become trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force;
  - (b) authorise him to construct as part of one of those slip roads a bridge over the navigable waters of the River Great Ouse.
- 2. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A428 Trunk Road and the slip roads to be constructed by him at Bedford in the county of Bedfordshire, which will authorise him to:
  - (a) improve a highway,
  - (b) construct a new highway,
  - (c) stop up highways,

  - (d) stop up private means of access to premises,
    (e) provide new means of access to premises,
- all at Bedford in the county of Bedfordshire.

Copies of each draft Order and the plans referred to in it, and the Environmental Statement which the Secretary of State has published in relation to the construction of the new highways and the improvement of an existing highway referred to in the draft Orders listed above, may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours from 12th July 1994 until 31st August 1994, or within 7 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, at the offices of the Highways Agency, Room 12/03, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1; at the offices of the Director, Eastern Construction Programme Division, Highways Agency, Heron House, 49-53 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL, of Bedfordshire County Council, County Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, and Bedford Borough Council, Town Hall, St. Paul's Square, Bedford; at the libraries in Harpur Street and Punce Street, Bedford; at the post office in Dane Street, Bedford and the sub-post offices at 193 and 432 Goldington Road, Bedford, 219 London Road, Bedford, 37 Bedford Road, Willington and 14 Quantrelle Court, Shortstown.

Any person may object to the making of either of these Orders not later than 31st August 1994, or within 7 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport at the office of the Director, Eastern Construction Programme Division, Highways Agency, Heron House, 49-53 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL, quoting ref. 504265/A428/47 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
