HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of Durham (Cone Terrace to Picktree Lane, Chester-le-Street) Classified Road (Side Roads) (No 2) Order 1993.

The Secretary of State for Transport here by gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the County Council of Durham (Cone Terrace to Picktree Lane, Chester-le-Street) Classified Road (Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 1993, which was made by Durham Conty Council under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed authorises the Council:

- (a) to stop up highways
- (b) to improve highways

all in or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the County Council is proposing to (a) improve from the Unclassified Road Cone Terrace extending 41 metres in a northerly direction and (b) construct from a point 41 metres north of the Unclassified Road Cone Terrace in a generally nothern direction to the Road B6313 Picktree Lane, all in the County of Durham.

Copies of the Order (as confirmed) and of the relevant plans may be inspected, free of charge, during all reasonable hours at the offices of the County Secretary and Solicitor, County Hall, Durham, and of Chester-le-Street District Council, at the Civic Centre, Chester-Street, and at the Department of Transport, Government Office for the North East, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne.

Any person aggrieved by the Order, and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any Regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 13th July 1994, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or any provision contained therein.
