With very few exceptions buildings within the Conservation Area may not be demolished except with the consent of the Local Planning Authority, and there are other special controls relating to extensions and alterations. Trees may not be topped, lopped, felled, uprooted or wilfully damaged or destroyed, unless notice of this proposed action has been given to the Local Planning Authority and permission to proceed has been received from them or they have failed to take conclusive action regarding the notice within six weeks from the time it was served. Trees already included in any Tree Preservation Orders are not subject to this procedure; but are subject, instead, to the more stringent requirements of the appropriate order.

A plan showing the precise extent of the Conservation Area is available for public inspection between the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Fridays at the main reception desk of the Development Services Division, East Hampshire District Council, Penns Place, Petersfield. A copy of the plan is also deposited with the Clerk to Greatham, Parish Council, at Todmore, Petersfield Road, Greatham, Liss GU33 6AD.
