White Point Road/North Promenade, South/East/South sides from a point opposite the North side of Mulgrave Road to a point opposite Wrelton Court.
North Terrace:
North side that length which lies between the junction of Argyle Road and East Terrace.

South side that length which lies between the junction of Argyle Road and East Terrace excluding the areas of restricted waiting around the junction of Royal Crescent.
Royal Crescent:
North side that length which lies between its westerly and easterly junctions of with North Terrace.
South/West sides that length which lies between the junctions of North Terrace and Crescent Avenue.
East Terrace, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of North Terrace and Crescent Place.
Crescent Place, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of East Terrace and the Esplanade.
Esplanade, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of North Terrace and Crescent Place.
Hudson Street, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of Esplanade and Crescent Avenue.
John Street, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of Belle Vue Terrace and Crescent Avenue.
Belle Vue Terrace:
West side that length which lies between the junctions Hudson Street and John Street.

East side that length which lies between the junctions of Crescent Place and Albert Place.
Crescent Avenue, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of Upgang Lane and Royal Crescent.

Argyle Road, both sides that length which lies between the junctions of Upgang Lane and North Terrace.
Ladssmith Averue, both sides that length which lies to the west of its junction with Argyle Road.

South-west side that length which lies between the junctions of White Point Road and Upgang Lane.

North-east side that length which lies between Upgang Lane and Caedmon Avenue.

Mulgrave Crescent, both sides that length which lies between its southerly and northerly entry points from Mulgrave Road.
Valley Road, both sides that Jength which lies between the junctions of Upgang Lane and Mulgrave Road.
Church Square, South/West/North (outer kerb-line) side that length which lies between the northerly and southerly entrance points from Crescent Avenue.
Khyber Pass, South/East sides that length which lies between the junctions of Pier Road and East Crescent.
East Crescent, South/West sides that length which lies between its junction with Khyber Pass and Crescent Place.
Royal Crescent, east side that length which lies between its junction with North Terrace and Crescent Avenue.

North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Disc Parking Limitations) (Various Roads, Boroughbridge) Order 1994.

Notice is hereby given that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and 4(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:
(1) prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in any length of road specified in Part 1 of the following table (except for certain exempted purposes including the loading and unloading of goods);
