NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SEVERN TRENT REGION

Notice of application for consent for the purposes of section 88

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Severn Trent Water Limited, for consent to discharge flows in excess of 37 litres per second of storm sewage to the Rea Brook at National Grid Reference SJ48511012 from the storm sewage overflow rear of Mary Webb Road, Meole Brace, Shrewsbury.

Any person who wishes to make representations about the application should do so in writing to the Area Consents Officer at Authority's offices at Hafren House, Shelton, Shrewsbury SY3 8BB, during the period 18th July 1994 to 29th August 1994 quoting ref. WA/US/4420.

The application is to relieve foul flooding from the manhole in public footpath. Consent is required on a temporary basis until implementation of a capital scheme scheduled for completion by 31st March 1996.

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Variation) (No.) Order 199
