Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Jamont UK Ltd., of Oughtibridge Mill, Oughtibridge, Sheffield, is applying to the National Rivers Authority to vary licence serial number 2/27/5/139, to abstract water from River Don, at National Grid Reference SK 2993 9444, at Wharnecliffeside, Oughtibridge, Sheffield, South Yorkshire. The variation being applied for is to increase annual licensed abstraction from 8,046,000 cubic metres to 8,601,000 cubic metres, to allow year round abstraction of water for turbine cooling only. The daily abstraction rate will not alter.

Barrow-in-Furness Borough Council Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that on 15th July 1994, the Council of the
Borough of Barrow-in-Furness made the following Order under the

Borough of Barrow-in-Furness made the following Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which are also set out below.

The County of Cumbria (Borough of Barrow-in-Furness) (General Traffic Control) Order 1994

The effect of the Order is:

- To prohibit waiting at any time in lengths of Albert Street, Back Abbey Road, Baldwin Street, Blake Street, Bath Street, Church Street, Cliffe Lane, Durham Street, Devon Street, Fairfield Lane, Hartington Street, Hawcoat Lane, Holker Street, Infield Park, Manor Road, North Scale, Rating Lane, Risedale Road, Roose Road, School Street, The Strand, Sutherland Street, Thorncliffe Road, Vulcan Road, Wheatclose Road and Wordsworth Street.
- To prohibit waiting for all vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in lengths of Back Milton/Drake Street, Back Wordsworth Street/Shakespeare Street and Back Shakespeare Street.

3. To prohibit waiting for all vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Friday in lengths of Black Butts Lane, Devonshire Road Thurlow Way and Woodland Park

Road, Thurlow Way and Woodland Park.

4. To introduce limited waiting parking places (Waiting Limited to 2 hours, No Return within 4 hours, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday) in lengths of Albert Street, Brown Street, Church Street, Collingwood Street, Dumfries Street, Farm Street, Florence Street, Marsh Street, Penrith Place, Penrith Street, School Street, Sutherland Street and Trinity Street.

5. To introduce limited waiting parking places (Waiting Limited to 1 hour, No Return Within 2 hours, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday) in lengths of Drake Street, Dryden Street, Hartington Street, Holker Street, Milton Street, Shakespeare

Street and Wordsworth Street.

 To prohibit the driving of all vehicles except heavy goods vehicles and armoured security vehicles along lengths of Cavendish Street and Dalton Road.

 To prohibit the driving of all motor vehicles, along Harley Street, except where a vehicle is being used:

(i) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated in or adjacent to Harley Street; or

(ii) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to Harley Street, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of Harley Street, or the laying erection

alteration or repair in or adjacent to Harley Street of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic lines or traffic sign or telecommunication apparatus.

To regulate the issue and use of residents' exemption parking permit.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting when directed or permitted by either a Police Constable or Traffic Warden, and for the purposes of:

(a) picking up or setting down passengers;

- (b) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of roads and the supply and maintenance of any gas, electricity, water and telecommunications operations (if no other road can be conveniently used);
 - (c) the pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
 - (d) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
 - (e) using a hearse or bridal car;
 - (f) police, fire brigade and ambulance services;
 - (g) loading or unloading goods.

The Order also makes exemptions for vehicles which display a disabled persons' badge and a parking disc showing the time of arrival in respect of those lengths of road listed in paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Copies of this Order which comes into operation and statements of the Council's reasons for making this Order are available for inspection at the Council's offices at the Town Hall, Duke Street, Barrow-in-Furness, between the following hours: Monday to Thursday, 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Friday 8.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of these Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to any Orders may within 6 weeks of the date on which that Order was made, make an application for that purpose to the High Court.

The Hertfordshire (High Street and Various Adjoining Roads, Berkhamsted) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that the Hertfordshire County Council intend to introduce traffic calming measures including speed tables, pinch points, traffic islands etc. and propose to make an Order under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 20 m.p.h. speed limit on the lengths of the following roads in Berkhamsted:

- (a) That length of High Street from a point 75 metres south-east of the centre-line of its junction with St. John's Well Lane, southeastwards to its junction with Manor Street.
- (b) The entire lengths of the following roads:
 - (i) Church Lane,

 - (iii) Prince Edward Street,
 - (iv) Rectory Lane,
 - (v) Water Lane.
