ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A12 Trunk Road (Marlesford to Benhall) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1994

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A12 Trunk Road in Suffolk.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 5th September 1994 will be that a 50 m.p.h. speed limit will be imposed on two lengths of the A12 Trunk Road on either side of Farnham. To the south-west of Farnham the 50 m.p.h. will extend for 5271 metres and to the north-east it will extend for 940 metres on the north-eastbound carriageway and 1215 metres on the south-westbound carriageway.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision in the Order on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made under any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the publication of this notice, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision in it.

The A5 Trunk Road (Nesscliffe Bypass) Compulsory Purchase Order (WMT No.) 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above, which he proposes to make, authorising him to purchase compulsorily:

- (a) the land and rights described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of:
 - (i) the construction of a new trunk road at Nesscliffe in the district of Shrewsbury and Atcham in the county of Shropshire in pursuance of the A5 Trunk Road (Nesscliffe Bypass) Order 199 ,
 - (ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said district and county in pursuance of the A5 Trunk Road (Nesscliffe Bypass) Side Roads Order 199 ,
 - (iii) the improvement of the A5 Trunk Road in the said district and county,
 - (iv) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road, the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above, and
 - (v) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;
- (b) the land and rights described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of mitigating any adverse effects which the existence or use of certain of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved by him as mentioned above will have on the surroundings thereof

Copies of the draft Compulsory Purchase Order and of the plan referred to therein, together with copies of the published drafts of the above-mentioned Trunk Road Order and Side Roads Order (both with their accompanying plans), have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 1st July 1994 to 30th September 1994 at the offices of the Highways Agency, Room 1205, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE, and at the offices of the Highways Agency, West Midlands Construction
