## WATER RESOURCES ACT

### NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY

#### *Notice of application for a licence to abstract water*

Take notice that G. P. Gott, Downham House Farm, Werekham, King's Lynn, Norfolk is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from the River Wissey, Norfolk, at National Grid Reference TL66769778 in the parish of Werekham, in the district of West Norfolk in the county of Norfolk. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 54.5 cubic metres per hour, 1,200 cubic metres per day, 27,300 cubic metres per year between 1st April and 31st September each year. The application is in effect a renewal of Licence No. 6/33/50/47/5 which expires on 30th September 1994, with no changes. The water will be used for spray irrigation of arable crops.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other document submitted with it may be inspected, free of charge, at Downham House Farm, Werekham, King's Lynn, Norfolk, at all reasonable hours during the period beginning 30th July 1994 and ending 27th August 1994.
