

## POOLE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Poole (Traffic Management) (Amendment Nos. 94 to 97, 99, 102-107 Inclusive) Order 1994 and*

*The Poole (Brudenell Road/Chaddesley Glen Area) (Street Parking Place) Order 1994*

Notice is hereby given that Poole Borough pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Dorset County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council has, on 19th July 1994, made Orders under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 32(1), 35(1) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984. The effect of the Orders, which come into effect on 26th July 1994, is as follows:

- (1) *Abingdon Road:*
  - (a) Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the north and west sides from the entrance to No. 1 to the entrance to No. 3.
  - (b) Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the southern side from Nuffield Road for 40 metres.
  - (c) Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the southern and eastern sides from the eastern entrance to No. 2 to the southern entrance to Nos. 10-24.
- (2) *Cowley Road:* Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the northern and eastern sides, from Nuffield Road to the entrance to Nos. 1-13.
- (3) *Nuffield Road:*
  - (a) Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the western side from the termination of the existing restrictions near Hatch Pond Road to 15 metres north of Cowley Road.
  - (b) Impose no waiting at any time restrictions on the eastern side from the termination of the existing restrictions to the junction with Abingdon Road.
- (4) *Stinsford Road:* Extend the existing no waiting at any time restrictions on both sides of the road beyond the entrance to "New Fields".
- (5) *Alton Road/Steepdene/Wyndham Road:* Impose waiting restrictions on the south-east/north-eastern side (odd numbers) from Osborne Road to No. 7 Alton Road and on the other side at the junctions of Wyndham Road and Steepdene.
- (6) *Willow Park:* Extend the existing restriction on the northern side to the layby near Nos. 7-8.
- (7) *Harbert Avenue:* Impose additional waiting restrictions at the Alder Road junction from the existing terminal point to No. 21 on both sides of the road.
- (8) *Parish Road:* Change the time of restrictions from the working day to all hours and impose a loading ban.
- (9) *Warren Road:* Remove the no waiting at any time restriction between the kerb extension and the limited waiting at the Courthill Road junction and replace it with limited waiting.
- (10) *The Quay:* Change the existing 30 minute limited waiting area to 2 hour parking between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the following lengths of road:
  - (a) Northern side—from a point 50 metres east of its junction with Bennetts Alley to a point 5 metres west of its junction with Castle Street.
  - (b) Southern side—from a point 33 metres east of Custom House steps for a distance 21 metres in a westerly direction.
- (11) *Brudenell Road:* Provide an "on-street parking place" on the lengths of carriageway which do not already have restrictions imposed and replace a length of approximately 30 metres of no waiting at any time restrictions on the south side between the accesses to "Water's Edge" with an on-street parking place.
- (12) *Haven Road (between Shore Road and Chaddesley Glen) Chaddesley Glen and Brudenell Avenue:* Provide an "on-street parking place" on all lengths of carriageway not already covered by no waiting at any time restrictions.

A copy of the above-mentioned Orders is available for inspection at the Civic Centre, Poole. If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant Regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make provision for the purpose to the High Court.

*Cemetery Road, Binstead,* on the east side from a point 45 feet south to a point 60 feet south of the junction with Binstead Hill.

*Cemetery Road, Binstead,* on the west side from a point 45 feet south of the junction with Binstead Hill to a point 45 feet north of the junction with Arnold Road.

*Garfield Road* on the north side from the junction with Victoria Street to a point 30 feet west thereof.

*Great Preston Road* on the south side from a point 45 feet west of the western junction with Smallbrook Lane to a point 200 feet west of the junction with A3055 at Westridge Cross.

*Great Preston Road* on the north side from a point 45 feet west of the western junction with Smallbrook Lane to a point 400 feet west of the junction with A3055 at Westridge Cross.

*Lower Highland Road* on both sides from the junction with Surbiton Grove to a point 25 feet north-east thereof.

*Park Road* on the north side from the junction with West Hill Road to a point 45 feet east of the junction with St. John's Wood Road.

*Park Road* on the south side from the junction with West Hill Road to a point 100 feet west of the junction with Hollytree Close.

*Pitt Street* on the east side from the junction with Upton Road to the end of the cul-de-sac.

*Playstreet Lane* on the south side from the junction with Pellhurst Road to the junction with the access to Haylands Primary School.

*Playstreet Lane* on the north side from a point 70 feet east to a point 155 feet east of the junction with the access to Haylands Primary School.

*Playstreet Lane* on the north side from a point 150 feet west to a point 330 feet west of the junction with Pellhurst Road.

*Ringwood Road, Binstead,* on both sides from the junction with Binstead Road to a point 45 feet south thereof.

*Smallbrook Lane* on both sides from the junction with Great Preston Road to a point 100 feet west thereof.

*Southfield Gardens* on both sides from the junction with Bettesworth Road to a point 45 feet north thereof.

*Surbiton Grove* on the north-east side from the junction with Lower Highland Road to a point 60 feet south-east thereof.

*Surbiton Grove* on the south-east side from the junction with Lower Highland Road to a point 25 feet south-east thereof.

*Upper Highland Road* on both sides from the junction with St. John's Hill to a point 25 feet south-west thereof.

*Westfield Park* at the eastern junction with Spencer Road on the east side from a point 45 feet north of the junction with Spencer Road to a point 45 feet north of the access road to the garages.

*Westfield Park* at the eastern junction with Spencer Road from a point 90 feet north of the junction with Spencer Road to a point 45 feet north of the access road to the garages.

*To limit the Waiting of Vehicles to 1 Hour in Any Two 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in the following length of road:*

*Lind Street* on the north side from a point 25 feet west to a point 80 feet west of the junction with St. James' Street.

*To revoke existing restrictions in the following lengths of road*

*Chapel Road, Binstead,* on the east side from a point 25 feet south to a point 135 feet south of the junction with Binstead Hill.

*Playstreet Lane* on the north side from the junction with the access to Haylands Primary School to a point 70 feet east thereof.

*Playstreet Lane* on the north side from a point 155 feet east of the junction with the access to Haylands Primary School to a point 330 feet west of the junction with Pellhurst Road.

*West Street* on the east side from a point 45 feet south to a point 145 feet south of the junction with Milligan Road.

A copy of the draft Order, this notice and the relevant plan may be inspected between normal office hours at the Reception Desk, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight during the objection period. If you wish to object to the proposed restrictions contained in this notice you should send the grounds for your objection, in writing, to the undersigned not later than 12 noon on 19th August 1994.
