The Portsmouth (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting and Three Hour Waiting) (No. 22) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 18th July 1994, made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Notice of the Council's intention to make this Order was first given in Issue No. 53644 of *The London Gazette*, dated 18th April 1994, Reference No. 495, page 5751, and the effects of the final Order are as described below:

The Order comes into operation on 1st August 1994.

A. *Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time (See also Item E below)*

1. *Dartmouth Mews* throughout its length.
2. *High Street, Old Portsmouth:*

(a) on the north-west side from a point 9 metres north-east of the junction with Lombard Street to a point 30 metres north-east of that junction;

(b) on the south-east side from a point 16 metres north-east of the junction with Pembroke Road to a point 54 metres north-east of that junction.

B. *Replacement of Prohibition of Waiting with Three Hour Waiting (Monday to Saturday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.)*

St. Michael's Road, on the east side within the layby, from a point 50 metres south of the junction with King Richard I Road in a southerly direction to the southern for a distance of 11 metres.

C. *Change of Restriction from One Hour Waiting (Monday to Saturday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.)*1. *St. Michael's Road:*

(a) on the east side within the layby from a point 21 metres south of its junction with King Richard I Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 13 metres;

(b) on the east side within the layby from a point 44 metres south of the junction with King Richard I Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.

D. *Prohibition of Loading and Unloading (Previously Advertised under the Portsmouth (Old Portsmouth High Street)) (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading and Amendment to Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 2) Order 1991)*

High Street, Old Portsmouth, the south-east side, from the junction with Pembroke Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres.

E. *Prohibition of Waiting (Previously Advertised under the Portsmouth (Old Portsmouth High Street)) (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading and Amendment to Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 2) Order 1991)*

High Street, Old Portsmouth:

(i) the north-west side, from a point 9 metres south-west of its junction with Lombard Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 43 metres (outside part of the Cathedral);

(ii) the south-east side, from a point 18 metres south-west of its junction with Pembroke Road, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 8 metres (outside part of No. 45).

A copy of the Order and a map may be seen at the Information Desk, Civic Offices, Portsmouth, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 25th July 1994, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
