In accordance with the Articles of Guide of the IMOGB, notice is given by the International Ministerial Council of Great Britain, a Member of the Council of Churches for Britain and Ireland, designated by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York under the Church of England (Ecumenical Relations) Measure: That Rev. Dr. S. Amaga, Leader and Minister of Foundation Faith Church of Rivers State, Nigeria, shall be ordained in November 1994 as the first IMOGB Pentecostal Bishop of Nigeria and shall be responsible to the Council in all constitutional undertakings as one of the Bishops of various overseas territories that shall have responsibility to monitor movements of Church workers on behalf of the IMOGB, in line with Her Majesty's Immigration and Nationality Division, in accordance with the clarified paragraphs 38 and 123 of provisions for the going, coming and residing of ministers and other Church workers to the UK in line with the arrangement within the understanding and rules of the Council and the IND: that no minister who does not hold a certificate of membership and a current ministerial licence granted by IMOGB or one of the bodies which are part of the ecumenical measure will be recognised by the Council. All Governments and High Commissioners have been notified of this.
