UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of All Souls College, in the University of Oxford on 12th March 1994, amending Statute VI, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Little Chippenham, Monmouth, Gwent) Order 1994

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development consisting of car parking and the relocation of an electricity substation associated with the warehouse food store development, for which planing permission has been granted, to be carried out.
