Northampton Borough Council (Abington Area) (Prohibition of Driving and one way traffic) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that on 28th July 1994 Northampton Borough Council as agents for the Northamptonshire County Council and in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made an Order the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit driving in Ashburnham Road at its junction with Oakwood Road for a distance of one metre each side of the projected line from the north-west corner of that junction to the south-east corner of that junction.

2. Prohibit vehicles proceeding in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice except in the direction specified.

Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
