- 3. To provide access to Regent Street via the western carriageway of the High Street:

 - (a) Between 10.30 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. to permit holders only.(b) Between midnight to 10.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. to midnight to permit holders, for access and for loading only.

A copy of the Order together with maps showing the affected roads and copy amended Order may be examined at the Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, Cleveland, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers concerned by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that a requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the 22nd July 1994, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Surrey County Council (North Camp Station Level Crossing, Ash Vale) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 199
