The QUEEN has graciously approved the creation of two new Commendations to be awarded solely in recognition of acts of bravery. They are the Queen's Commendation for bravery and the Queen's Commendation for bravery in the air. They will be available to civilians, and to military personnel not in action against the enemy. The use of the existing Queen's Commendation for brave conduct and Queen's Commendation for valuable service in the air in the United Kingdom will be discontinued. (1 SI)
