#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The A580 Trunk Road (East Lancashire Road, Salford) (Closure of Gap in Central Reservation and Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 199.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A580 Trunk Road known as the East Lancashire Road in the City of Salford.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) close the gap in the central reservation of the A580 Trunk Road approximately 80 metres east of its junction with Old Clough Lane, and
- (b) prohibit vehicles from turning right onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from Old Clough Lane.

#### ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980 (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that, as provided by Article 4 of the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980 (as amended) the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and Welsh Office Agriculture Department have, with effect from 19th August 1994 issued the following licences, as detailed below: A. NEW GENERAL LICENCE

Subject: Fresh/refrigerated poultry meat carcases/part carcases and/or offal derived from domestic quail, pigeon, pheasant and partridge.

Country of origin: Austria, Finland, Norway and Sweden.

Conditions attaching to licence:

1. Each consignment must be accompanied by:

EITHER

(a) A commercial document issued in accordance with the terms of Article 3 1A(i) of Council Directive 71/118/EEC as amended and updated by Council Directive 92/116/EEC.

OR

(b) In the case of consignments intended for a Member State or region of a Member State recognised as being free of Newcastle Disease or a Member State after transit through a third country, each consignment must be accompanied by a health certificate in accordance with Council Directive 91/494/EEC amended by Council Directive 92/116/EEC, signed by an official veterinarian of the country of origin stating;

(i) Details of the consignment i.e. species, nature of cuts, nature of packaging, number of cuts or packages, month(s) and year(s) when frozen, net weight;

(ii) Addresses(es) and veterinary approved number(s) of the slaughterhouse(s), cutting plant(s) and cold store(s);

(iii) Destination of meat (place of loading, country and place of destination, means of transport - for railway wagons or goods vehicles the registration number should be given, for aircraft the flight number and for boats the name) names and addresses of consignor and consignee.

(iv) Health Attestation.

I the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that the poultrymeat  $(^1)$  described above satisfies the requirements of Council Directive 91/494/EEC of 26th June 1991 on animal health conditions governing intra-Community trade in and imports from third countries of fresh poultrymeat and also the requirements of the second subparagraph of Article 3(A)(1) of that Directive, if such meat is destined for a Member State or region of a Member State that is recognised as being free of Newcastle Disease.

2. The document or certificate required above must be the original document or certificate except in the case of products entering Great
