TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (Town Hall Lane and Part of Market Street, Lampeter, Dyfed) Order 1994

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made, on the application of the Ceredigion District Council, an Order under section 249 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 extinguishing, subject to some exceptions, any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice.

Copies of the made Order and relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Ceredigion District

Council, Local Office, Town Hall, Lampeter, or may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF5 4PL (quoting Ref. ZC510-5-2-1).

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act, he may, within 6 weeks of 21st October 1994, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

Any person, who at the time of coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to the length of the highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Ceredigion District Council, as the local planning authority, in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. Any claim for such compensation must be submitted within 6 months of 21st October 1994.

SCHEDULE

(All distances are approximate)

The highway is situated at Lampeter in the county of Dyfed and is that length of highway known in part as Town Hall Lane and in part as Market Street which extends from its junction with High Street in a general northerly and then easterly direction to the rear of the National Westminster Bank property, a total distance of 55 metres.
