The A259 Trunk Road (Folkestone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1)and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A259 Trunk Road in the District of Shepway in the County of Kent. The effect of the Order would be to impose the following waiting

restrictions on the A259 in Folkestone:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at all times on a length of Shorncliffe Road, from the western side of its junction with Earl's Avenue eastwards for a distance of 50 metres on the north side and eastwards for a distance of 68 metres on the south side;
- (b) to prohibit waiting at all times on both sides of a length of Earl's Avenue, from its junction with Shorncliffe Road southwards for a distance of 35 metres; and
- (c) to restrict waiting on the north-western side of a length of Black Bull Road to one hour (with no return permitted within two hours) from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday, from a point 20 metres north-east of its junction with Albion Road/Mead Road to a point 41.1 metres south-west of its junction with Canterbury Road.

The A435 Trunk Road (Puffin Crossing Alcester Road, Studley) (Prohibition of Waiting and Overtaking) Experimental Order 1994

Notice is hereby given, that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under sections 9(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A435 Bath-Lincoln Trunk Road (Alcester Road, Studley) in the District of Stratford-upon-Avon in the County of Warwickshire.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting and overtaking (for a distance of approximately 40 metres) within the zig-zag markings of the puffin crossing situated on the A435 Trunk Road approximately 52 metres from the junction with Bell Lane.
