

- (c) to prohibit waiting at all times and to introduce a loading ban from 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and from 4.30 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays on certain lengths of Dewsbury Road (south side), between Whitehall Street and Basford Street and Horbury Road (south-east side), from the end of the one-way section at St. Michael's to a point opposite Co-operative Street.
- (d) to extend the waiting ban (currently 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays) to apply from 7.30 a.m. to 6 p.m. on those days on a length of Dewsbury Road (north side) from Whitehall Street to No. 114 Dewsbury Road.

The opportunity is being taken to revoke and re-enact a number of existing restrictions on Dewsbury Road, Horbury Road and the unnamed link road between Horbury Road and Dewsbury Road.
