Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council in exercise of the powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make the Wigan Borough (Christopher Street, Ince) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1994.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting on Christopher Street, Ince:

 North-east side from Sephton Street for a distance of 7 metres in a north-westerly direction.
