

The effect of the Order will be to prevent any vehicle except a bus or coach from waiting/stopping in that part of Sawyers Hall Lane from its junction with Highland Avenue in a northerly direction for the entire length of the publicly maintainable highway.

A copy of the draft Order together with a map showing the lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available at the office of the undersigned where they may be inspected during normal office hours. Copies are also on deposit at Local Government Library (E Block) County Hall, Chelmsford, Essex.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should write to the undersigned stating the reasons for your objection by 9th December 1994.

BROXBOURNE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Broxbourne (Various Roads, Hoddesdon)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1994*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Broxbourne, pursuant to arrangements made with the Hertfordshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit, at any time, the waiting of vehicles at the following locations in Burford Street (north), Hoddesdon:

- (i) East side, from a point in line with the northern boundary of the building "Burford House", extending in a southerly and south-easterly direction for a distance of 81 metres into the north side of Essex Road, Hoddesdon;
- (ii) East side, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 86 and 88, extending in a northerly and north-easterly direction for a distance of 32 metres into the south side of Essex Road, Hoddesdon;
- (iii) East side, from a point in line with the southern boundary of house No. 81, extending in a southerly and south-easterly direction for a distance of 71 metres into the north side of Dinant Link Road, Hoddesdon;
- (iv) West side, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 108 and 110, extending in a northerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres into the south side of Duke Street, Hoddesdon;
- (v) West side, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 90 and 92, extending in a southerly and south-westerly direction for a distance of 45 metres into the north side of Roman Street, Hoddesdon;
- (vi) West side, from a point 6 metres south of a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 54 and 56, extending in a northerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of 72 metres into the south side of Roman Street, Hoddesdon.

2. Prohibit, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. (Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive), the waiting of vehicles at the following locations in Brewery Road, Hoddesdon:

- (i) South side, from a point 4 metres west of a point in line with the boundary between Units 3 and 4 of the Hoddesdon Business Centre, extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres;
- (ii) North side, from a point 4 metres west of a point in line with the boundary between Units 3 and 4 of the Hoddesdon Business Centre, extending in an easterly, north-easterly, northerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of 132 metres.

3. Prohibit between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m., and between the hours of 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. (Mondays to Fridays, inclusive), the waiting of vehicles at the following locations in Benford Road, Sheredes Drive and Warners Avenue, Hoddesdon:

- (i) West side of Benford Road, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 28 and 30, extending in a northerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of 70 metres;
- (ii) East side of Benford Road, from a point in line with the southern boundary of house No. 22, extending in a northerly and north-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres;
- (iii) North side of Benford Road, from a point 17 metres east from a point in line with the eastern boundary of house No. 7,

- extending in a easterly, north-easterly and northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres into Warners Avenue, Hoddesdon;
- (iv) East side of Sheredes Drive, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 24 and 26, extending in a south-westerly and southerly direction for a distance of 26 metres;
- (v) East side of Sheredes Drive, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 13 and 15, extending in a southerly and south-easterly direction for a distance of 44 metres into the north side of Benford Road, Hoddesdon;
- (vi) West side of Sheredes Drive, from a point in line with the boundary between house Nos. 24 and 26, extending in a south-westerly, southerly, westerly and north-westerly direction for a distance of 135 metres into the east side of Warners Avenue, Hoddesdon;

4. This will result in amendments to the following existing Order:

- (a) *The County of Hertford (Town Centre Roads, Hoddesdon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969*

The proposed Order contains exemptions as set out below in respect of certain lengths of the roads specified above and full details of these exemptions can be obtained by inspecting the draft Order and the maps contained in it indicating the lengths of roads concerned.

- (i) Boarding or alighting from vehicles.
- (ii) The loading or unloading of goods.
- (iii) Building or demolition work.
- (iv) The removal of any obstruction to traffic.
- (v) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road specified above.
- (vi) The laying of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water and electricity or telecommunications apparatus.
- (vii) Emergency Service vehicles.
- (viii) Street cleansing and refuse collection vehicles.
- (ix) Street trading operating with the consent of the Borough of Broxbourne.
- (x) The delivery and collection of postal packets.
- (xi) Disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the Order as drafted and the maps contained in it showing the lengths of roads concerned, together with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and the Order referred to in paragraph 4 above, may be inspected at the office of the undersigned between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

Any objections to the proposed Order, together with grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned at the address set out below, to be received no later than 9th December 1994.

The Metropolitan Borough of Bury (Simister Lane, Prestwich) (Prohibition of Driving) (Peak Period Restrictions) (Experimental) (No. 2) Order 1994.
