The East Sussex (Vicarage Road and Brightland Road, Eastbourne) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will remove, amend and introduce new No Waiting At Any Time restrictions along the following lengths of roads:

*No Waiting "At Any Time" in**Vicarage Road, north-east side:*

From its junction with Church Street, to 10 metres south-east of its junction with Brightland Road. (extended by 10 metres)

From 5 metres north-west of its junction with Greys Road, to 5 metres south-east thereof. (removed from outside of Nos. 13-15)

From the boundary between Nos. 25 and 27 Vicarage Road, to the boundary between Nos. 31 and 33. (removed from outside of No. 19 to and including No. 25)

*Vicarage Road, south-west side, from its junction with Church Street to 13.7 metres east of its junction with Glebe Close. (extended so as to run between Nos. 10-20 Vicarage Road)**Brightland Road, south side, from its junction with Vicarage Road, eastwards for 10 metres. (new restriction)*

A copy of the draft Order, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at these offices between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday to Friday inclusive, at Eastbourne Central Library, Grove Road and at Eastbourne Borough Council's Town Hall Main Reception Area until 16th December 1994.

The East Sussex (Various Roads in Eastbourne) (Ambulance Parking Places) Consolidation Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under section 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will increase the number of Ambulance Parking Places in Eastbourne to nine by introducing a new Parking Place along the following length of road:

Ambulance Parking Place

Belmore Road, south side, from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Willowfield Road, eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.

The provision of the parking place is to meet the needs of the elderly and infirm residents of the adjacent Riverbourne House.

A copy of the draft Order, plans showing the lengths of roads affected and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at these offices between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. inclusive, at Eastbourne Central Library, Grove Road, and at Eastbourne Borough Council's Town Hall Main Reception Area until 16th December 1994.

Additionally various old Orders have also been revoked, but at the same time reproduced, so as to incorporate all of Eastbourne's existing Ambulance bays, together with the new proposal outlined above into this Consolidation Order.

The East Sussex (Cavendish Place, Eastbourne) (Experimental Restriction of Waiting) Order 1994 Amendment Order 1994 No. 1

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council have made an Order on 16th November 1994, coming into operation on 28th November 1994, under sections 9, 10(1) and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, for an Experimental period not exceeding seven months which extends the existing Experimental Order which restricts waiting on Monday to Saturday to 15 minutes within a two hour period, to a period of 30 minutes within two hours along the following length of Cavendish Place:

Waiting limited to 30 minutes within any period of two hours Monday to Saturday 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Cavendish Place, north-east side: from 14 metres south-east of its junction with Longstone Road, south-eastwards to 14 metres north-west of its junction with Tideswell Road.

Before the introduction of the original Experimental Order which came into effect on 17th January 1994, two hour waiting was allowed in any four hour period along the above length of Cavendish Place.

A copy of the Order, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the County Council's reasons for making the Order may be examined at my office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive, at Eastbourne Library, Grove Road and at Eastbourne Borough Council, Town Hall Reception, until 29th May 1995.

East Sussex County Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions should be continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any person wishing to object to this Order being continued in force should send any such objection in writing, together with the grounds on which it is made, to me at the address below by 29th May 1995 (or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified by an Order made under sections 9, 10(1) or 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, six months from the date of coming into operation of such variation or modification).

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of 16th November 1994, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The East Sussex (North Court, Lewes) (Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council have made an Order on 16th November 1994, coming into operation on 21st November 1994, under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which prohibits vehicles from both driving and waiting along the following lengths of North Court.

North Court, Lewes

Prohibition of Driving, from a point 1.9 metres north of its junction with Cliffe High Street, northwards for 2 metres.

This will be enforced by the installation of bollards, so preventing the use of the road by traffic of a kind, or in a manner, which is unsuitable as regards the character of the road adjoining the property.

Prohibition of Waiting "At Any Time", both sides: from its junction with Cliffe High Street, northwards for a distance of 112 metres.

A copy of the Order, together with plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the County Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at these offices between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. inclusive until Wednesday, 4th January 1995.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of The Road Traffic Act or any
