The Caradon District Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Council proposes to make an Order under section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act amending the Caradon District (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1991, (hereinafter referred to as the 1991 Order).

It is intended that the proposals will come into effect on 1st April 1995.

The effect of this Order will be:

1. At the end of Article 10 of the 1991 Order there shall be added the following:

(5) Where any vehicle is left in a parking place to which Article 6(2)(a) of this Order applies for longer than the period paid for and an Excess Charge ticket has been issued, the driver may elect to pay a discount penalty payment as follows for this particular offence:

(i) If the driver returns to the vehicle within one hour of the expiry time of the parking ticket, the fee payable shall be sixty pence (60p) including VAT, such sum to be paid through the parking ticket machine at the time of return to the vehicle.

(ii) If the driver returns between one and two hours after the expiry time of the parking ticket, the fee payable shall be six pounds (£6.00) including VAT, such sum to be paid through the parking ticket machine at the time of return to the vehicle.

2. At the end of Article 26 of the 1991 Order there shall be added the following:

(3) Where the driver of a vehicle has contravened any of the provisions of Articles 4, 11, 12, 13, 15, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23 and 24 of this Order a Fixed Penalty or Excess Charge of thirty pounds (£30.00) inclusive of VAT, shall become due and a notice shall be completed and attached to the vehicle in accordance with Article 10(2)(a) to (e). Payment of the Fixed Penalty will be in accordance with provisions of Article 10(3).

3. For Article 21(e) of the 1991 Order there shall be substituted the following:

(e) For the purpose of depositing or causing to be deposited any advertising, handbills, leaflets or circulars on any vehicle in a parking place, and without prejudice to the generality of this Article, a person shall be deemed to be causing an advert, handbill, leaflet or circular to be deposited if that person's goods, trade, business or other concerns are being given publicity by the advert, handbill, leaflet or circular unless that person can prove that it was deposited without that person's consent.

4. In the First Schedule to the Principal Order under the heading *Downderry* there shall be inserted the following:
