

To prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on:

- (i) the west side of St. Leonard's Road from a point 9 metres south of Malmesbury Park Road to a point 9 metres north of Stuart Road.
- (ii) the west side of St. Leonard's Road from a point 9 metres south of Stuart Road to a point 9 metres north of Lowther Road.

(Both existing unrestricted)

33. Southville Road

To prohibit waiting at any time on:

- (i) north-west side from a point 44 metres from Southbourne Road to a point 25 metres from Seabourne Road.

The Devon County Council (A373 and Greenway Lane, Awliscombe) (30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that on 16th November 1994 Devon County Council made the above Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as published in *The London Gazette* No. 53637 dated 11th April 1994 (Ref. No. 493) to come into force on 28th November 1994.

DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

The Durham County Council (Borough of Darlington) (Unclassified Clifton Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 1994.

Notice is hereby given that the Durham County Council have made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle other than a cycle as defined in section 196 of the Road Traffic Act 1972, to enter the unnamed access road between 58-60 Clifton Road, leading to back Roslyn Street North from its junction with Clifton Road in a westerly direction for a distance of one metre.

The Order which comes into operation on 21st November 1994, contains exemptions in respect of building operations and demolitions; maintenance of the road; fire brigade, police or ambulance vehicles; and statutory powers.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the affected road, may be inspected at the office of the Borough Solicitor and Head of Administrative Services at the Town Hall, Darlington, during normal office hours on Monday to Friday.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the ground that any requirement of that section of the said Act of 1984 or of Parts I, II and III of Schedule 9 to the said Act or any regulation made under the said Part III have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks
