Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Mr. J. Butterworth of Brook End Green Farm, Barton-le-Clay, Bedfordshire, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from a watercourse at National Grid Reference TL 076308 at Barton-le-Clay, Bedfordshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 15 cubic metres per hour, 333 cubic metres per day and 30,000 cubic metres per year between 1st January and 31st March 1995, in the first year and 1.25 cubic metres per hour, 30 cubic metres per day and 900 cubic metres per year between November and March thereafter.

The water will be used for filling and maintaining the level of an amenity lake.
