

6. To revoke part of the Schedule of the County of Devon (Wolseley Road, Plymouth) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order 1975 as specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

The County of Devon (The Parade, Barbican, Plymouth) (Various Traffic Orders) Amendment Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- To add to Schedule 1 (Pay and Display Parking) of the Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading (The Barbican Area, Plymouth) Amendment Order 1987 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order No. 1") parts of the south side, north side, east side of the Parade and part of the north side and east side of the island in the Parade.
- To revoke part of Schedule 1 of the Principal Order No. 1 insofar as it relates to parking spaces numbered 9, 10 and 11 in relation to the north side, east side of the Parade and part of the island in the Parade.
- To amend the relevant paragraph of Principal Order No. 1 and Schedule No. 1 by reducing the maximum period of stay, during the permitted hours from 2 hours to 1 hour.
- To add to Schedule 2, Part 1 of the Principal Order No. 1, Barbican Court.
- To amend part of Schedule 2, Part 1 of the Principal Order No. 1 by deleting item number 4 in relation to the Parade and replacing it with a new item number 4 in relation to the Parade.
- To amend the County of Devon (The Parade, Barbican, Plymouth) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order No. 2") by amending paragraph 3 by increasing the maximum period of stay from 2 hours to 3 hours and amending that paragraph to read (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- To revoke the existing Schedule of Principal Order No. 2 and replace it with another Schedule dividing the Parade south side into two parts.
- To amend the Schedule of the County of Devon (The Parade, Barbican, Plymouth) (Parking Places) Order 1991 by deleting Parking Place No. 1, in relation to the north side of the Parade and replace it with another definition of the north side of the Parade.
