NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting) (B6274 Gilling Road, Richmond) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that on 14th November 1994, North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting (except for certain exempted purposes including the loading and unloading of goods) at any time in any length of road specified in the following table:

TABLE

Roads in the Town of Richmond

- Earl Edwin Drive*, both sides, from its junction with the centre line of Gilling Road, for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.
- Conan Drive*, south side, from its junction with the centre line of Gilling Road, for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.
- Gilling Road*, west side, from its junction with the centre line of Conan Drive, for a distance of 125 metres in a southerly direction.
- Gilling Road*, east side, from its junction with the centre line of Earl Edwin Drive, for a distance of 85 metres in a northerly direction.
- Gilling Road*, east side, from its junction with the centre line of Earl Edwin Drive, for a distance of 57 metres in a southerly direction.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 21st December 1994, together with a map showing the roads affected, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Richmond Divisional Office, 18 Green Howards Road, Richmond DL10 4NR, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of

any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks of 26th November 1994, make application to the High Court for the purpose.

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991

Notification of Substantial Road Works

In accordance with section 58 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991, three month's advance notice is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council and Gloucester City Council (Highway Authority) intend to carry out substantial works for road purposes.

The streets in which these works will take place are as follows:

- 1.* Abbeymead Avenue/North Upton Lane Roundabout, Gloucester. Construction of new roundabout. Start date, January 1995.
- 2.* Elmbridge Road, Gloucester. Carriageway and footway resurfacing with traffic calming. Start date, February 1995.

Subject to the exemptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in the above schemes without the consent of the said Gloucestershire County Council (Highway Authority) which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
