Notice is hereby given that on 26th January 1995 the Kent County Council made an Order the effect of which will be to permit the waiting of vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a period of one hour (with return prohibited within one hour) on the south-west side of Holly Bush Lane, Sevenoaks from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Dartford Road for a distance of 18 metres in a south-easterly direction. The Order will come into operation on 6th February 1995.
