North Yorkshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (A684 Morton-on-Swale) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th January 1995 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit any vehicle from travelling at a speed of more than 30 m.p.h. on each length of road specified in Part I of the following table.
2. Revoke the Traffic Regulation Order specified in column 1 of Part 2 of the following table to the extent specified or referred to in column 2 of that part of the table.

A684 Ainderby Steeple and Morton-on Swale, from a point 41.5 metres east of its junction with the centre line of Potter Lane (measured along the southern kerb-line of the A684) eastwards to a point 71.5 metres east of its junction with Green Hills Lane, (measured along the southern kerb-line of the A684).
Station Lane (Morton-on-Swale), from its junction with the A684, northwards to a point 120 metres north of its junction with the centre line of St. Helen's Close (measured along the eastern kerb-line of Station Lane).
