ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A140 Ipswich-Norwich Trunk Road (Tasburgh) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order, which comes into

operation on 26th March 1995, will be that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 m.p.h. on that length of the Trunk Road known as the A140 Ipswich-Norwich Trunk Road in the county of Norfolk from a point 360 metres south of its junction with Church Road to a point 840 metres north of that junction (a distance of approximately 1,200 metres).
