THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Cardiff—Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Cancoed to Minffordd Improvement) Order 1995

The Cardiff—Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Cancoed to Minffordd Improvement Side Roads) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes between Cancoed and Minffordd in the County of Gwynedd, shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation:

- a route about 245 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 1,910 metres south-west of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 1,620 metres south-west of that bridge;
- a route about 220 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 1,520 metres south-west of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 1,270 metres south-west of that bridge;
- a route about 330 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 1,025 metres south-west of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 385 metres south-west of that bridge;
- a route about 330 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 1,025 metres south-west of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 385 metres south-west of that bridge;

a route about 160 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 240 metres south-west of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge end terminating at a point on the trunk road about 80 metres south-west of that bridge;

a route about 110 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 25 metres south of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 110 metres north-east of that bridge;

a route about 350 metres in length, starting at a point on the trunk road about 285 metres north-east of the Roman Bridge Railway Bridge and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 670 metres north-east of that bridge:

NOTE: All distances of commencement and termination shown above are measured along the centreline of the existing trunk road:

2. an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980;

(a) authorising him:

- i. to carry out the improvement of highways;
- ii. to stop up highways;
- iii. to construct new highways;
- iv. to stop up private means of access to premises; and
- v. to provide new means of access to premises;

All on or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned new trunk roads; and

(b) providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the county council of Gwynedd as from the date on which he notifies the council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
