THE MANCHESTER PLAN

The Unitary Development Plan for the City of Manchester

Notice is hereby given, that Manchester City Council propose to modify these plan proposals.

A list of the proposed modifications (other than modifications which the authority are satisfied will not materially affect the content of the plan proposals) with the authority's reasons for proposing them are available for inspection at Reception, City Planning Department, Level 7, Town Hall Extension, Albert Square, Manchester M60 2JT from 9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Monday to Fridays and at Wythenshawe Library, The Forum, Civic Centre, Wythenshawe M22 5RT, during normal opening hours from Thursday, 16th February 1995 until Wednesday, 29th March 1995 inclusive. Copies of the plan proposals, the report into the objections by Dennis Midgley, the Inspector who held the Public Inquiry and the authority's statement of reasons and decisions as respects objections to the plan proposals are similarly available for inspection.

The City Council has accepted all of the recommendations in the report with the exception of Policy DB/16. The recommendation which the Council does not intend to accept is available for inspection with the above documents, together with an explanation of the reasons for this decision.

Objections to, and representations in respect of, the proposed modifications, and to the intention not to modify the plan proposal in accordance with recommendation to DB16 in the report, should be sent in writing to the City Planning Officer, Box 488, Town Hall, Manchester M60 2JT, by 4 p.m., Wednesday, 29th March 1995. Objections and representations should specify the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made, and may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of the withdrawal, adoption, approval or rejection of the plan proposals. Forms for making objections and representations are available from the Planning and Environmental Health Department.

If no objections are received during the period given for making objections, Manchester City Council intends to adopt the proposals on the expiry of that period.

The Council has taken on board the recommendations of the Inquiry Inspector and has modified the Plan accordingly. There is only one exception to this that materially affects the Plan. This is in

relation to Policy DB16, where the Council has taken a line which reflects the spirit of the Inspector's recommendation but does not follow it to the letter.

An explanation of the approach adopted by the Council is available for inspection along with the material set out above in the "official" notice.
