The Cambridgeshire County Council (North-West Cambridgeshire Zone) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that, the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police the effect of which will be to:

Prohibit heavy commercial vehicles, the maximum gross vehicle weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from using roads in the Parishes of Barnack, Bainton, Deeping Gate, Etton, Helpston, Maxey and Northborough which link the B1443 with the A15 and A16, Lincolnshire County Council will be introducing similar restrictions to cover the lengths of road in that County.

Heavy commercial vehicles requiring access for loading and unloading, servicing, or off-street garages at premises on, or adjacent to, or only accessible from, the affected roads will still be allowed to use the roads.
