- 1. Newbridge Industrial Estate Access Road "A"
 - (a) Western side from its junction with Newbridge Road for a distance of 15 metres.
 - (b) Western side from a point 55 metres north of its junction with Newbridge Road for a distance of 35 metres in a northerly direction.
 - (c) Western side from a point 25 metres south of its junction with Access Road "C" for a distance of 79 metres in a northerly direction.
 - (d) Eastern side from its junction with Newbridge Road for a distance of 174 metres in a northerly direction.
