

## SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Somerset County Council (Main Street, Chilthorne Domer) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 199*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Somerset propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at the junction of Main Street with Tintinhull Road, Chilthorne Domer, as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The usual exemptions will apply for picking-up/setting-down passengers, loading/unloading, for disabled drivers, for the maintenance of the roads or services therein or for emergency vehicles.

A copy of the draft Order, a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Post Office, Chilthorne Domer, or at County Hall, Taunton during normal opening hours.

## SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Somerset County Council (Venns Gate and Hannay Road, Cheddar) (Weight Restriction) Order 1994*

Notice is hereby given that on 17th February 1995, the County Council of Somerset made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes in an easterly direction along Hannay Road and north-westerly along Venns Gate, Cheddar.

The Order comes into effect on 27th February 1995.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the length of road affected may be inspected at County Hall, Taunton during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 17th February 1995 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## ST. EDMUNDSBURY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*St. Edmundsbury Borough Council (Parish of Haverhill) (Murton Slade) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Street Parking Places) Order 1995.*

Notice is hereby given that St. Edmundsbury Borough Council as agents for Suffolk County Council propose to make the above Order under sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of this will be to:

- Prohibit waiting at all times in parts of Murton Slade.
- Limit waiting at 30 minutes between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday, return prohibited within 3 hours in part of Murton Slade.
- Prohibit waiting at all times except for disabled persons badge holders in bays marked for this purpose in part of Murton Slade.

Full details may be obtained from the Order.

Exemptions to the waiting restrictions allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board and alight; goods to be loaded and unloaded; for building, industrial or demolition works; for the maintenance of the road or the services therein and for certain other purposes specified in the Order. There are also other exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the draft Order and a plan showing the roads affected, together with the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of St. Edmundsbury Borough Council at Angel Hill, Bury St. Edmunds and Lower Downs Slade, Haverhill between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Thursday and between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Friday.

Objections to the Order, specifying the grounds on which they are made, must be made in writing to the Director of Technical Services, St. Edmundsbury House, Western Way, Bury St. Edmunds, Suffolk IP33 3YS, and must not arrive later than 16th March 1995.

## THAMESDOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL

(A) *The Borough of Thamesdown (Prospect (Radnor Street Cemetery to Victoria Road) Swindon) (Residents' Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1995.*

(B) *The Borough of Thamesdown (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions and Loading and Unloading Restrictions, Swindon) Order 1978 Amendment Order (No. 2) 1995.*

Notice is hereby given that the Thamesdown Borough Council as agent to the Wiltshire County Council proposes to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the respective effects of which will be as follows:

(A) To amend the Residents' Parking Places Order to include the following lengths of road as parking places:

*Areas on Highways Designated as Parking Places with Permits*

*Eastcott Road*, east side, from a point 31 metres south of its junction with North Street to a point 9 metres north of its junction with South Street.

*Prospect Hill*, east side, from a point 20 metres north of its junction with North Street to a point 87 metres north of that junction.

(B) The waiting restrictions will also be amended:

*No waiting at any time**Eastcott Road:*

East side, from its junction with North Street to a point 31 metres south of that junction.

East side, from a point 9 metres north of its junction with South Street to a point 8 metres south of its junction with King William Street.

*Prospect Hill:*

East side, from its junction with North Street to a point 20 metres north of that junction.

West side, from its junction with North Street to a point 19 metres north of that junction.

West side, from a point 29 metres north of its junction with North Street to a point 30 metres north of that junction.
