NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Barnsley Wortley Parish Public Footpath No. 49 Howbrook Temporary Stopping-up (No. 1) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 247, 253 and 261 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, proposes to make an Order if planning permission is granted by him for development to be carried out consisting of the extraction of coal by opencast methods and subsequent development as a golf course on land off Westwood New Road, Howbrook, Wortley, Barnsely.

The effect of the Order will be to stop up for a period not exceeding 2 years a strip of land, namely Footpath No. 49, which runs from Carr House Farm to where it meets Footpath No. 50, which runs adjacent to Storrs Dike. The lines and situation of the existing highway are shown on the map annexed to the Order.

A copy of the Order and the map contained it has been deposited at the offices of Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council and may be inspected, free of charge, during normal working hours.
