between two Blazing Hearths also proper may be borne and used, together with such Crest and such Supporters as may be proper to be borne and used, by King's College London on Seals, Shields or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms, the said Armorial Ensigns being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and declaration be recorded in the said College of Arms. (4 SI)
