TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (Bryn Road, Lampeter, Dyfed) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, following a public local inquiry held on 31st January 1995, he has made the above Order under section 249 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 extinguishing, subject to certain exceptions, any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on that length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice.

Copies of the Order and annexed plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at the offices of District Council, Local Office, Town Hall, Lampeter, during a period of 6 weeks from 5th May 1995.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may within 6 weeks of 5th May 1995 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The highway is situated at Lampeter in the county of Dyfed and is that length of Bryn Road which extends from its junction with Church Street for a distance of approximately 95 metres in a westerly direction to its junction with Temple Terrace. (481)
