*The Stopping-up of Highways (Croescardarn Road, North Pentwyn, Cardiff, South Glamorgan) Order 1995*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in Schedule 1 to this notice.

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Wimpey Homes Holdings Ltd. by Cardiff City Council on 28th October 1994, under ref. 94/01405/N.

Copies of the made Order and the relevant plan may be inspected during normal opening hours (10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., Mondays to Thursdays; 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 7 p.m., Fridays and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 5.30 p.m., Saturdays) at Llanedeyrn Library, Maelfa Shopping Centre, Llanedeyrn, Cardiff, or may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting ref. ZC 5105730).

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds:

- that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or
- that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of 27th June 1995, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### SCHEDULE 1

*(All distances are approximate)*

The highway to be stopped up is at North Pentwyn, Cardiff, in the county of South Glamorgan. It is shown by zebra hatching on the annexed plan and is an area of Croescadam Road, roughly dewdrop in shape, which extends from the edge of its junction with the road which gives access to Llanedeyrn Farm in a northerly direction for a distance of 22 metres on its eastern side, has a maximum width of 7 metres and total area of 88.5 square metres.
