*The North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Right Turn—  
Hurricane Way into Clifton Moorgate) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that on 28th July 1995 North Yorkshire County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle proceeding along Hurricane Way at its junction with Clifton Moorgate to make a right turn into Clifton Moorgate.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 1st August 1995, together with a map showing the roads affected, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, and at York Area Office, Fulford Lodge, 1 Heslington Lane, Fulford, York, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks of 1st August 1995, make application to the High Court for the purpose.
