SCHEDULE 1

24 hour no stopping clearway

Bexhill Road, between its junction with Telford Road (A406) and a point 18.29 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Telford Road.

Bounds Green Road, (A109), between its junction with Pinkham Way and Telford Road and the boundary of the London Borough of Haringey.

Bull Lane, between its junction with Sterling Way (A406) and a point 13 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Sterling Way.

Evesham Road, between its junction with Telford Road (A406) and a point 18.29 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Telford Road.

Station Road (A109), the north-east side, between its junction with Telford Road (A406) and a point 54.85 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Telford Road.

Station Road, (A109), the south-west side, between its junction with Pinkham Way (A406) and a point 47.24 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Pinkham Way.

Tewkesbury Terrace, between its junction with Telford Road (A406) and a point 18.29 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Telford Road.

Taplow Road, between its junction with the eastbound off-slip road of North Circular Road (A406) and the south-western kerb-line of Hedge Lane.

The unnamed access road leading to the westbound on-slip road of North Circular Road (A406) from Ostliffe Road.

Borough of Macclesfield (Off-street Parking Places, Macclesfield, Handforth, Prestbury, Poynton, Bollington and Disley) Order

Borough of Macclesfield (Off-street Parking Places, Macclesfield No. 7) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Macclesfield Borough Council, acting pursuant to arrangements made with Cheshire County Council in accordance with section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, or with the consent of Cheshire County Council, propose to make the above orders in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders will be as follows:
