*The Portsmouth (Commercial Road) (Bus and Cycle Lane)  
(No. 35) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that, the Portsmouth City Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect will be as follows:

**A. Bus and Cycle Lane**

A bus and cycle lane will be provided on part of the northbound carriageway of Commercial Road, from its junction with Fitzherbert Street, to its junction with Church Street Roundabout.
