TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of Suffolk)
(No.) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of the Ipswich Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 249 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on Providence Street, Ipswich.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway:

1. By vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) by a medical practitioner in cases of emergency;
- (c) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
