The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 347 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-Up of Highways (County of West Sussex) (No. 7) Order 1995", authorising the stopping-up of a length of Town Mead, Crawley, in the County of West Sussex.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the power of the above Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any Regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 9th August 1995, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.
