WINNINGTON COMBINED HEAT AND POWER DEVELOPMENTS LIMITED

Notice of application for consent to construct and operate a Combined Heat and Power Plant on land at Brunner Mond and Company's Wallerscote Site and Associated Pipeline Connections between Wallerscote, Winnington, and Lostock, all in Northwich in the Borough of Vale Royal, in the County of Cheshire.
