The A30 Trunk Road (Improvement at Minzies Downs) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A30 Trunk Road at Minzies Downs in the County of Cornwall, which authorises him to:

- (a) improve a highway
- (b) stop up highways
- (c) stop up private means of access to premises
- (d) provide new means of access to premises.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question its validity, or the validity of any provision in it, on the grounds that:

- (a) it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or
- (b) any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order,

may, within six weeks from 3rd August 1995, or within six weeks of the date of publication of this notice, if such a period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision contained therein.
