Proposed Stopping-up of a Highway at Accrington

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Hynburn Borough Council he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of parts of the westerly side of Peel Street, Accrington, which run through the Bus Station.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Hynburn Borough Council, on 31st August 1994, under Ref. 11/94/0327.

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 11th August 1995, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the Department of Transport, Government Office, North West, Sunley Tower, Piccadilly Plaza, Manchester M1 4BE.

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it.
