

CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Cheshire County Council (Smithy Lane, Crewe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire County Council intend to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations; to enable the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the road or the services therein; to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of its statutory powers and duties and to enable the delivery or collection of postal packets. The statutory exemption for disabled persons' vehicles is also included in the Order.

A copy of the draft Order, plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours in Room 273, County Legal and Member Services, County Hall, Chester, and at the offices of Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council, Municipal Buildings, Earle Street, Crewe.

Any objections to the proposed Order together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 11th September 1995.

CLEVELAND COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Cleveland (Borough Road, Middlesbrough) (Reserved Bus Lane) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Cleveland have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The new Order will come into operation on 21st August 1995, the effect of which will be to create a reserved bus lane on the right westbound lane of Borough Road approximately 70 metres in an easterly direction.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of road concerned may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the County Secretary, Cleveland County Council, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

CREWE AND NANTWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Crewe and Nantwich (General) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1995

Notice is hereby given that the Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council proposes to make an Order under section 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Cheshire in accordance with section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of this Order will be to:

- (a) restrict waiting on the car parks shown in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice to the periods and on the days shown in the Schedules to this notice;
- (b) impose a charge for a vehicle left in any of the car parks referred to in Schedule 1 to this notice at the following rate:

Up to 1 hour 25p
1 hour to 2 hours 50p

2 hours to 4 hours..... 75p
4 hours to 10 hours..... £1-00

(up to the maximum waiting time as shown in Schedule 1 to this notice), between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on the days shown in Schedule 1 to this notice. Parking will be free after 6 p.m. and before 8 a.m. and all day Sunday;

- (c) amend the operative hours as shown in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice;
- (d) revoke any current Off Street Parking Places Orders insofar as they relate to any of the car parks referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice.

NOTE: The Market Area car parks (Lyceum Square, Market Shed and adjacent area), Heath Street, Crewe, will operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays only and the Market Area car park, Churchyardside, Nantwich, will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays only. The other named car parks will operate on all days.

Full details showing these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with maps showing the restricted areas, copies of the Orders to be revoked and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be examined during the normal office hours at the District Office, Beam Street, Nantwich, and the offices of the Head of Legal Services, 7th Floor, Delamere House, Delamere Street, Crewe, and at the Reception Desk, Municipal Buildings, Earle Street, Crewe.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds of your objection in writing to the Head of Legal Services by 8th September 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This does not form part of the statutory notice)

The purpose of this Order is to implement a review of the car parking regime operated by the Borough Council. It is intended that certain car parks will remain free of charges while some others will become subject to "Pay and Display" regulations.
