## DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dyfed (Blue Street, Carmarthen) (Goods Vehicle Parking Place) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers. The effect of this Order will be to prohibit parking on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this notice except for goods vehicles parked in the position and for the time specified in the said Schedule.

*The County of Dyfed (Restricted Roads) Order 1995 (Imposition of 30 m.p.h. speed limit at Boulevard St. Brieuc, Aberystwyth)*

When this Order comes into effect the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice will become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

## DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dyfed (Various Roads, Carmarthen) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of this Order will be:

- (1) To prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- (2) To limit waiting to 30 minutes, with return prohibited within 30 minutes, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sunday on the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- (3) To revoke the County of Carmarthenshire (Various Streets, Carmarthen) (One-way Traffic and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 and the County of Dyfed (Blue Street, Catherine Street and Lamas Street, Carmarthen) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1990, insofar as they relate to the sides of road specified in the Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the sides of roads affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the said sides of roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, during normal office hours.

## SCHEDULE 1

*Prohibition of waiting at any time*

*Lamas Street, on the north side:*

- (i) From a point 28 metres east of the centre of its junction with Mansel Street for a distance of 33 metres in an easterly direction.
- (ii) From a point 16 metres west of the centre of its junction with Mansel Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.
